Article 19 of the UBC Statement of Faith



We believe that the end of the world is approaching; that at the last day Christ will descend from heaven and raise the dead, both righteous and wicked, from the grave to final retribution; that a solemn separation will then take place which will fix forever the final state of persons in heaven or hell, the wicked being adjudged to everlasting conscious punishment, and the righteous to everlasting life and joy.


